

VIETNAM PRIMARY HEALTH PLACEMENT

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Located in the ethnically diverse Mai Châu district, in northern Vietnam, 135 km north of Hanoi, this two or three week placement collaborates with remote village communes and the central health district on a variety of community development projects via the Mai Châu General Hospital.

These are focussed on delivering primary health outreach to disadvantaged populations through mobile clinics and health education workshops, placing student groups in uniquely experiential situations that alleviate poverty, respect indigenous cultures and protect local environments.

The placement begins in the Vietnamese capital city, Hanoi for workshop orientation. The three week option also sightsees some of the major sites in Hanoi to learn more about the country, its past and culture.

The hospital is extremely supportive of student groups visiting and assisting to provide healthcare outreach to outlying villages. Students are provided the opportunity to not only practice their nursing assessment skills under supervision but learn about the culture and the socioeconomics of the region.

The placement provides students the opportunity to observe and work in cooperation with doctors and nurses whilst also providing health checks and health education to residents in surrounding villages.
